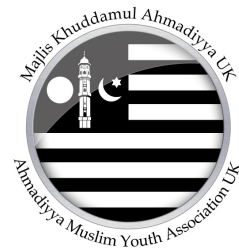


Every pound contributed...

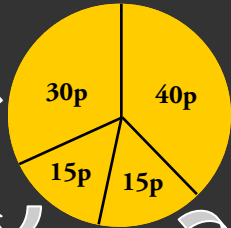
An explanation of which Chandas are collected by MKA UK and how these funds are spent



Khuddam Chanda

Every pound contributed in Khuddam Chanda...

Goes to the Markaz (Centre) for the propagation of Islam



Goes to the Local Administration to spend on local activities eg Local Ijtema, Forums etc.

Goes to the Regional Administration to spend on regional activities eg Regional Ijtema, Forums etc.

Goes to fund the national activities and events eg MKA CC, MKA Research Association, sporting events etc. The budget for each department is discussed at Majlis-e-Shura and sent to Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih for final approval.



Atfal Chanda

Every pound contributed in Atfal Chanda...

Goes to the National Atfal Department to spend exclusively on Majlis Atfalul Ahmadiyya; for the activities and events carried out by this department.



Ijtema Chanda

Every pound contributed in Ijtema Chanda...

Goes exclusively to help fund the National Ijtema which takes place every year to help facilitate brotherhood and is the largest event in the MKA UK calendar.



Tariq

Every pound contributed in the Tariq Fund...

Goes exclusively to help produce the national MKA UK periodical, the 'Tariq', meaning morning star. This magazine aims to help keep Khuddam up to date on news and events across the country, and also gives Khuddam the opportunity to submit scholarly articles for others to benefit.



Ta'amiraat Chanda

Every pound contributed in Ta'amiraat Chanda...

Goes exclusively to help raise funds for MKA UK properties. Currently, MKA UK is using this fund to help pay for 'Sarai Khidmat' which is located directly opposite the Fazl Mosque in London.



Sadaqah

Every pound contributed in Sadaqah...

Goes exclusively to help raise funds for the poor and needy in society solely out of love for God. As the Holy Qur'an states: 'And they feed, for love of Him, the poor, the orphan, and the prisoner, (Ch76,v9) Saying, "We feed you for Allah's pleasure only. We desire no reward nor thanks from you"'. (Ch76,v10)
